Re: Inflow/Infiltration (I/I) Reduction Program

This letter is to remind you that Point of Sale I/I Inspections are still required on ALL property transactions (residential and commercial buildings) connected to the sewer system in Duluth.

Please share this information with your staff.

Per City Ordinance 43-33.4, POS Inspections are required on **ALL** property transactions connected to the sewer system in Duluth. If the property is in compliance, a POS Certificate of Compliance will be created, and once the \$105 payment is made to the City of Duluth, the certificate will be released.

A copy of this certificate IS required at the time of the closing. If the property is not in compliance, 90 days will be allowed for repairs to be completed. **The City continues to offer grant funding for this sump pump program.** Once the project is completed, a Point of Sale Certificate of Compliance will be issued. If the repairs are not completed, a \$250/month surcharge will be added to the homeowner's utility bill.

To schedule your Point of Sale inspection, please call the scheduling desk at **218-730-4034** or **218-730-4130**. Point of Sale Inspections are scheduled Monday through Thursday 8:30 am to 3:00 pm and Fridays from 10:00 am - Noon.

Due to COVID-19 and the struggling City budget, we are forced close new lateral line grant funding to homeowners for 2021. Homeowners who are currently signed up, the grant funds allocated to their property are still available. We will be compiling a waiting list of people who are interested and when more funds become available will be determined on a first come first serve basis or if the line collapsed.
